The Friends of Pattermore House have been appointed the custodians of "Fairview" (Pattermore House) by the Sunshine Coast Council. The group collects and researches documents, stories, photographs and artefacts associated with the history of the property to promote "Fairview" to visitors through open days, historical displays, exhibitions and group tours.

The Friends are also restoring the heritage gardens with help from others, particularly the Maleny Garden Club. The house and surrounding land (2.4 ha) is a Queensland Heritage listed property situated in Maleny, Queensland. It was built in 1907 by the Pattermores, from white beech pit-sawn on the property. It is one of the oldest in-situ examples of early 20th Century farmhouses.
