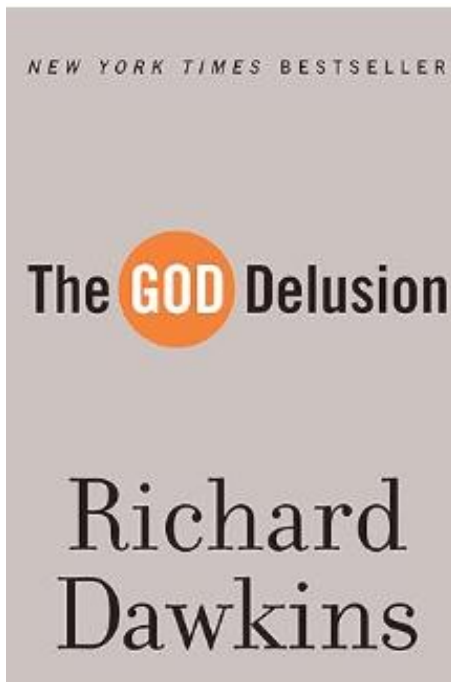


Richard Dawkins' New Atheism
